Country Roads News contacted the offices of West Virginia Gov. Jim Justice, U.S. Sen. Joe Manchin; U.S. Sen. Shelley Moore Capito; and Rep. Alex Mooney, whose congressional district includes Tucker County, for comment about their preferred route for Corridor H through Tucker County.

Capito and Mooney did not reply to emails and telephone calls. Staff members for Justice and Manchin responded with emails that didn't address the potential routes for the highway.
